Psalm 46:1

God is our Refuge and Strength [mighty and impenetrable to temptation], a very present and well-proved help in trouble.

Psalm 138:3

In the day when I called, You answered me; and You strengthened me with strength (might and inflexibility to temptation) in my inner self.

Psalm 143:10

Teach me to do Your will, for You are my God; let your good Spirit lead me into a level country and into the land of uprightness.

Proverbs 1:10

My son, if sinners entice you, do not consent.

Proverbs 1:16

My son, do not walk in the way with them; restrain your foot from their path, for their feet run to evil, and they make haste to shed blood.

Proverbs 4:14-15

Enter not into the path of the wicked, and go not in the way of evil men. Avoid it, do not go on it; turn from it and pass on.

Mark 14:38

Keep awake and watch and pray [constantly], that you may not enter into temptation; the spirit indeed is willing, but the flesh is weak.

Luke 22:40

And when He came to the place, He said to them, Pray that you may not [at all] enter into temptation.

Romans 12:21

Do not let yourself be overcome by evil, but overcome (master) evil with good.

James 1:12

Blessed (happy, to be envied) is the man who is patient under trial and stands up under temptation, for when he has stood and test and been approved, he will receive [the victor's] crown of life which God has promised to those who love Him.

James 4:7

So be subject to God. Resist the devil [stand firm against him], and he will flee from you.
